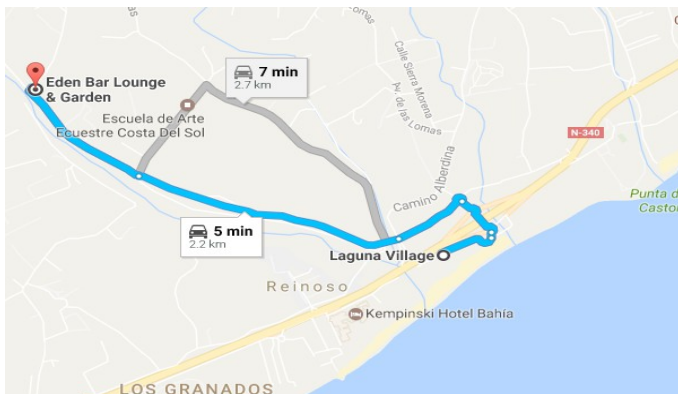
May Lunch Club Meet at the Jinete.

Looking Ahead to our June Special interest day Karting event

Now for something very different for our members that we have not tried out in the past. Nick has organised a Karting day. We will meet at Laguna Village at 10.30 for 11.00 departure, straight to the Karting facility above the second entrance to Estepona on A7. As this is a special interest event and the karting place has refreshment facilities we do not envisage a long run on the day. If we have a group of 6 or more we could have a race for 28€ a head which consists of a 5 min. timed practice session followed by an eleven minute race.



For 35€ per person you also get a 5 minute free practice session before classification. For those who do not want to race you can have an 8 minute session for 20€. These karts have 270cc engines so are quite fast. 14.30 departure from karting to lunch venue via a short run.
